- Illinois Valley Community College is receiving a new addition



Profile on Joliet Junior College Addition

Joliet Junior College recently expanded through a 17,800 square foot addition that included 16 service bays, 2 alignment racks, 4 classrooms, parts room, equipment room, 3 instructor offices, and a service manager office. This addition more than doubled the existing space of the automotive program.

Each of the 16 new service bays has a complete student toolkit, locker, and laptop computer to access vehicle service information. The \$5,000,000 project also received Silver Certification in Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design.









Profile on Parkland College New Facility

Parkland College opened a new Applied Technology Center that includes over 28,000 square feet of space for the automotive program. The facility includes 15 lift work stations of which 3 are alignment lifts. New classrooms, equipment rooms, and faculty offices are also included. The new facility more than doubled the previous facility space.

The project was built to Gold certification standards for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design.
