ISBE Professional Development Credits for Illinois High School Instructors

ICAIA will be offering **10 ISBE PD Credits** for Illinois High School Instructors attending both days of the ICAIA conference. These credits will be issued through Illinois Valley Community College (IVCC) which has graciously agreed to provide these PD Credits again.

Illinois high school instructors that need **ISBE PD Credits** should pick up a **ISBE Evaluation form** at the conference registration table on Thursday morning. The form will need to complete and returned to Art Koudelka (ICAIA Executive Treasurer) before leaving on Friday, by 12:15 pm. There will be a drop box at the registration table on Friday morning for your convenience.

If your evaluation form is not returned by Friday 12:15 pm., you will **not** receive ISBE PD Credits for the conference.

IVCC will email you your ISBE PD credits within a few weeks (after the conference) for the ICAIA High School Instructors that turned in their ISBE Evaluation form on time.

Hosting an ICAIA Conference FAQ's

1. My school does not have room. Can I host an ICAIA conference?

YES. ICAIA conferences have been hosted in smaller schools by placing the vendor show in a hallway and utilizing various other classrooms for training sessions. Only if you want to allow a vendor to bring in a large piece of equipment will the auto shop be necessary.

ICAIA has also held the vendor trade show in the host hotel banquet room with no auto shop. ICAIA has also had schools' partner together and split the conference between the 2 schools. There are numerous options, and we are here to discuss and help.

2. <u>I am a one-person or small program. Can I host an ICAIA conference?</u>

YES. ICAIA is here to help support you. ICAIA takes care of all the registration details. ICAIA can help with contacting vendors and presenters. What the host school needs to do is help coordinate lodging, facilities, food vendor, and banquet location. In fact, ICAIA is here to help with that as well if needed.

Remember to consider the possibility of partnering and co-hosting:

- Co-host between 2 schools, such as a local high school and college. Wow, talk about engaging your feeder/articulation schools and building a pipeline of students and cooperation!
 - o Consider having students from both schools help together in the set-up.
- Co-host with a local business partner. The local vendor/business partner may have numerous ideas to help with potential vendors and presenters. What a way to also help build your advisory board participation!
- Consider having your students form a leadership committee to help with:
 - Finding a host hotel and banquet location
 - Laying out and setting up the vendor trade show
 - Identifying local vendors
 - ICAIA and you can help take it from there!


