TENURE TRACK FACULTY – DIESEL POWERED EQUIPMENT TECHNOLOGY

Department – Agricultural & Industrial Technologies

Illinois Central College is seeking a qualified individual to provide lecture and laboratory instruction for the Diesel Powered Equipment Technology (DPET) Program. Responsibilities will include, but will not be limited to coordinating courses, maintaining tools and lab equipment, collaborating with full-time and part-time faculty, staff and industry professional. The full-time instructor organizes courses and provides technical instruction involving demonstration of the skills required by the industry, lectures on theory, practices, methods, processes, and terminology; instructing in the areas of agricultural equipment, construction equipment, on highway heavy trucks, diesel engines, planting equipment, harvesting equipment, air brakes and chassis, transmissions and final drives, fuel systems, electrical and electronic systems, hydraulics, GPS/guidance systems, and air conditioning. The instructor will plan, supervise and assess students in classroom as well as lab situations making sure all safety regulations are followed. The instructor will be expected to seek professional development to retain current with corporate trends and emerging technologies. The successful candidate must be able to work on a team with other faculty, administrators and industry partners; conduct internship supervision, evaluate the progress of student's technical knowledge and skills, assist in maintaining records required as part of internships, advisory council members and other colleagues to develop new curriculum to improve course or add to existing program; and follow College and corporate procedures, rules and regulations for safe operation and practice. Ensure the equipment functions safely, properly and meets requirements of the course being presented. Successful candidate must be able to work on a team with full-time and adjunct faculty and staff members.

Associate's degree in Heavy Equipment Technology or closely related curriculum.

Five years related field work in the heavy equipment repair industry and demonstrated teaching experience. The physical level of function is Medium, which is defined as lifting 60 pounds max occasionally, and lifting and/or carrying objects weighing 25 pounds max frequently. *Final candidates must successfully complete a physical determining that they meet the physical requirements of the job.*
