Illinois Central College is seeking a qualified individual to provide lecture and laboratory instruction for the Caterpillar Dealer Service Technology (CATTK) Program. Responsibilities will include, but will not be limited to coordinating courses, maintaining tools and lab equipment, collaborating with Caterpillar Inc. technician training and teaching Caterpillar Dealer Service technical courses. The full-time instructor organizes courses with practical and technical instruction involving demonstration of the skills required by the industry, lectures on theory, practices, methods, processes, and terminology; instructing in the areas of engine rebuilding, fuel systems, hydraulics, electrical systems, transmissions, and final drives; plans and supervises the work of students in the classroom, laboratory, to include setting up laboratory area for instruction as well as assist in maintaining and/or constructing training aids for teaching. Internship supervision- overnight travel is required for internship site visits; evaluating the progress of students technical knowledge and skills; assist in maintaining records required as part of internships; assist in ordering supplies for instruction; meet with corporate partners, advisory council members, and other colleagues to develop new curriculum to improve courses or add to existing program; seek professional development to remain current with corporate trends, emerging technology, the latest teaching tools; and follow College and corporate procedures, rules and regulations for safe operation and practice. Ensure the equipment functions safely, properly and meets requirements of the course being presented. Successful candidate must be able to work on a team with full-time and adjunct faculty and staff members.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

Associate's degree in Heavy Equipment Technology or closely related curriculum. Two years related field work in the heavy equipment repair industry and demonstrated teaching experience. The physical level of function is Medium, which is defined as lifting 60 pounds max occasionally, and lifting and/or carrying objects weighing 25 pounds max frequently. *Final candidates must successfully complete a physical determining that they meet the physical requirements of the job.*
