Teach a minimum of 15 semester credit hours per fall and spring semesters, maintain office hours, and assess student learning outcomes in automotive technology courses. Develop and promote automotive technology curriculum designed both as transfer courses to four-year colleges/universities, and certificates and applied degree programs. Work with occupational employer advisory committees to ensure program effectiveness. In collaboration with colleagues, be responsible for ongoing curriculum evaluation and improvement within the context of IVCC's general education philosophy. Facilitate student learning outside of the classroom through participation in student activities, college, and community events; assist with student recruitment.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in Automotive Technology (or related field) from an accredited college/university; ASE Master Automotive Certification; 2000 hours of related work experience; and a strong background in automotive electrical and electronic systems, engine performance and drivability, electronic engine controls, steering and suspension, and brake systems required. Preferred: Master's Degree in engineering or teaching; teaching experience at the college level in automotive technology; knowledge and understanding of Hybrid vehicles and light duty diesel. Must be able to stand for extended periods of time and be able to lift at least 40 lbs.
