

Title: NTT Faculty (Automotive Technology) (Technical Writing) (50%)

Position Summary: The School of Transportation at Southern Illinois University Carbondale is seeking applicants for a variable time, non-tenure, track faculty position within its Baccalaureate Automotive Technology program. Initial term appointment is anticipated to be 50% FTE with faculty rank based upon academic degree held. The position requires teaching undergraduate automotive technical writing/documentation courses beginning August 16, 2021.

One of the very few Baccalaureate Automotive Technology programs in the country supplying the industry, our program is recognized both nationally and globally for its excellence and prominence in the industry.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Carry an approved teaching load and maintain appropriate office hours.
- Manage classrooms, laboratories, tools, equipment, and other resources utilized.
- Provide educational and professionally related assistance to prospective and enrolled students.
- Engage in indirect instruction to support student learning and retention.
- Keep students apprised of grades as the semester progresses and enter final grades electronically within specified deadlines.
- Participate in professional associations, service, and outreach activities related to the discipline.
- Participate in program development, quality assurance and assessment duties as required.
- Remain abreast of recent developments and practices in the industry.
- Maintain training and credentials necessary for Program Accreditation.
- Comply with Program quality assurance and assessment requirements.

- Engage in other program/departmental assignments as determined by the Department Chair.

Minimum Qualifications:

An earned Master's degree or PhD, and professional experience in technical writing/documentation in a post-secondary academic or industry environment is required for appointment at the rank of Assistant Lecturer or Assistant Professor of Practice.

OR

An earned Baccalaureate degree with a minimum of three (3) years professional experience in technical writing/documentation in a post-secondary academic or industry environment is required for appointment at the rank Assistant Instructor.

Preferred Qualifications: Earned Masters or Ph.D. degree in automotive, English, engineering, technology, business, education, or a closely related discipline or related experience in the automotive wholesale/manufacturer or retail level.
