

POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

Southern Illinois University Carbondale School of Automotive

Description: The School of Automotive at Southern Illinois University Carbondale is seeking qualified applicants for **two** tenure-track Assistant Professor faculty positions starting August 16, 2023. These positions require teaching technical undergraduate automotive courses, teaching business and management courses, conducting research within the field of study, and providing service to the profession, students, and University.

Qualifications: Earned Master's degree in management, business, education, automotive, engineering, or a closely related discipline, is required by the time of appointment. A minimum three (3) years of related experience in the automotive or mobility industries. Applicants must demonstrate the potential for conducting and pursuing independent, externally funded research. Strong written and oral communication skills are required.

Function:

The Tenure-track role within the School of Automotive is expected to include teaching responsibilities for nine credit hours per semester plus, conducting a minimum of one research publication per year to broaden the body of knowledge in the automotive or similar mobility disciplines. In addition to teaching and research, tenure-track candidates are also expected to provide service to the profession, students, and university.

Application Deadline: Review of applicants will begin immediately and continue until filled. For fullest consideration, applications should be received by Monday, April 30, 2024.
